



## CHR & Rhythmic CHR – June PPM

June's highlights include new CHR leaders in Houston (where CBS Radio's "Hot" edges Cumulus' **KRBE**) and Atlanta (Lincoln Financial-owned "Star" overtakes Cumulus' "**Q100**"). There's also a one-share May-June gain by Houston Rhythmic CHR "The Box" (**KBXX**). Debuting in these overviews are data from recently-added PPM markets Miami, Seattle, Phoenix, Minneapolis and San Diego. A 1.0 share (6+) in an applicable PPM-measured June 2009 survey was required to appear in these CHR and Rhythmic CHR summaries. Dual asterisks (\*\*) designate non-metro stations.

#### Gains/Losses

- In somewhat of an oddity, CHR ups **(31%)** and evens **(31%)** are the same – while concurrently - there’s also about the same number of downs **(38%)**.
- Typical gains are **+.28** (compared to **+.35** in May) while representative losses are **-.40**, versus **-.36** in May.

### AQH Share

For the sixth consecutive month, **WXKS-FM/Boston (“Kiss”)** scores the strongest 6+ numbers among CHRs in PPM-based markets, although the **Clear Channel** station is down for the fourth straight time.
